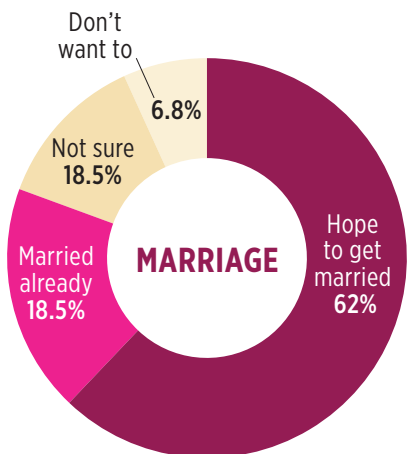
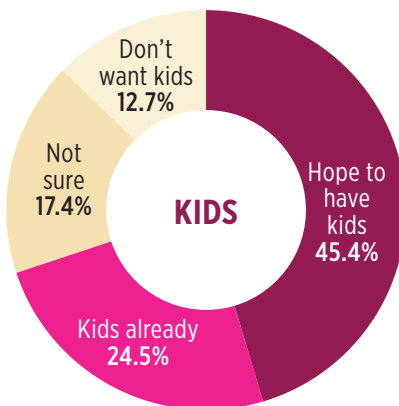

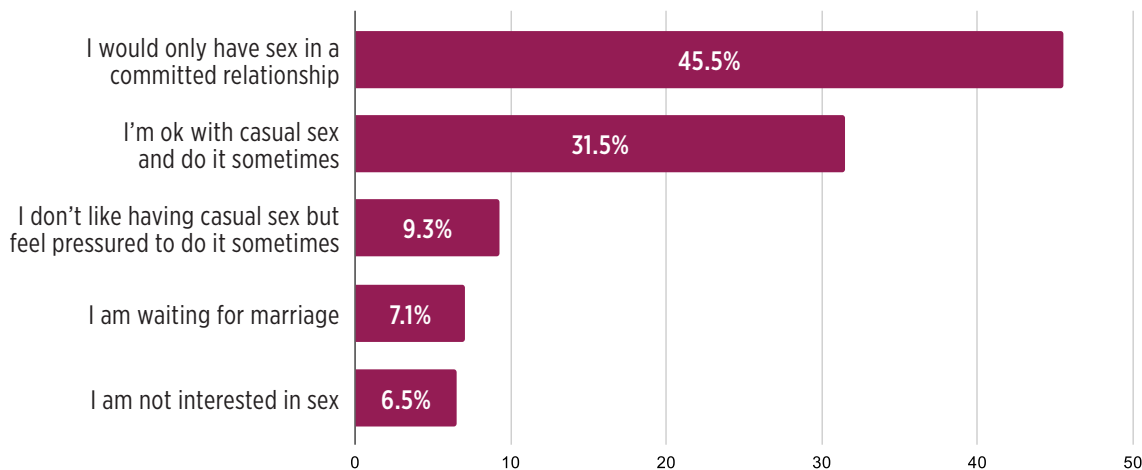
Select Results from National Poll of 1000 Young Adults (aged 18-29)



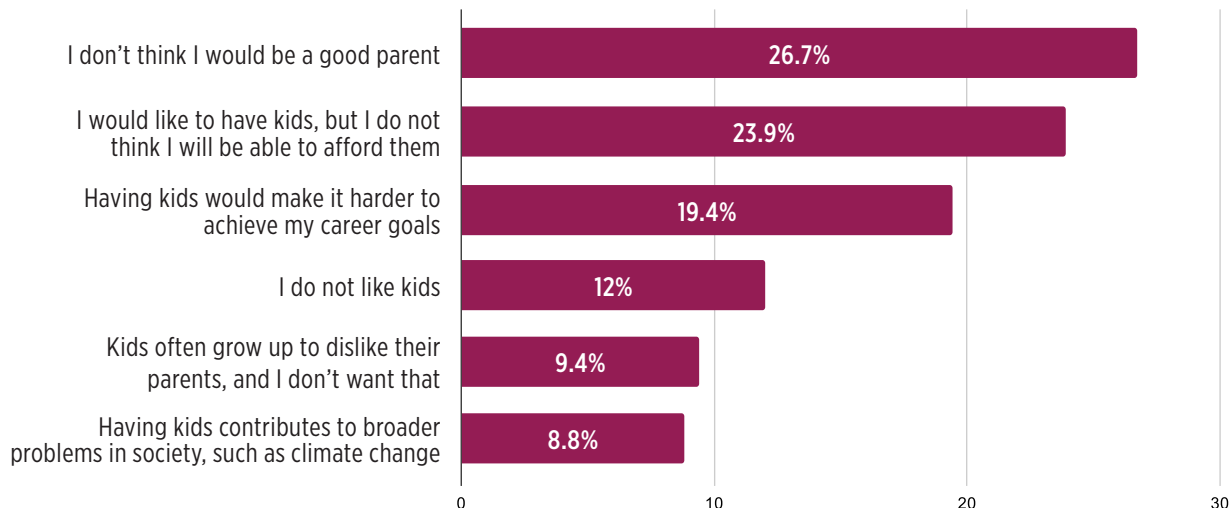
The overwhelming majority of young adults —men and women—still want to get married and have kids.



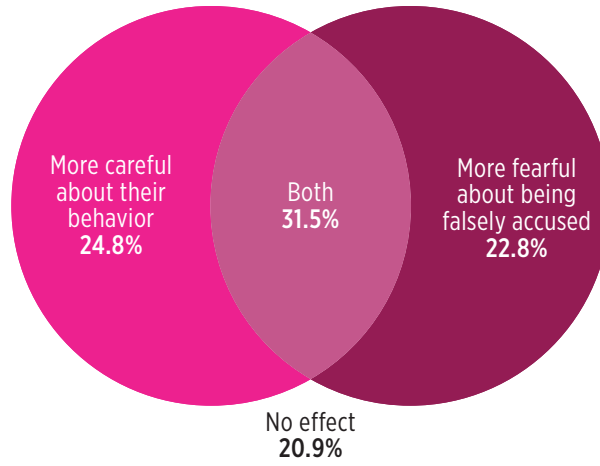
Most (52.6%) young adults want sex only within a committed relationship (including marriage).



Reasons young adults say they don't want kids.

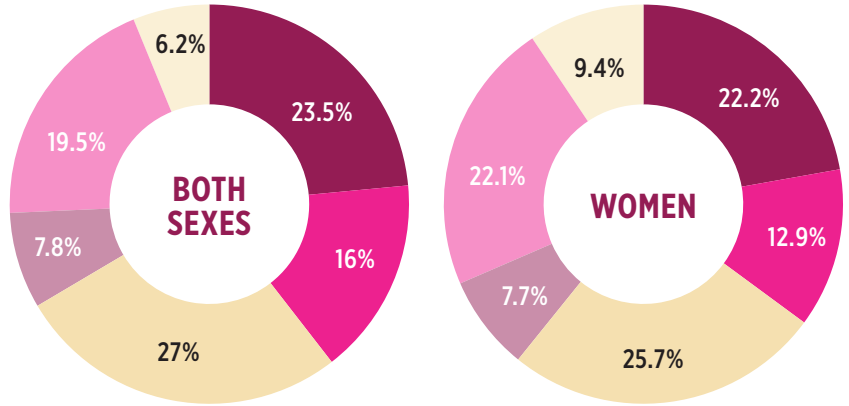


Most young adults (54.3%) agree that #MeToo has made men “more fearful of false accusations and therefore less interested in dating.”

- Marriage is patriarchal and bad for women
