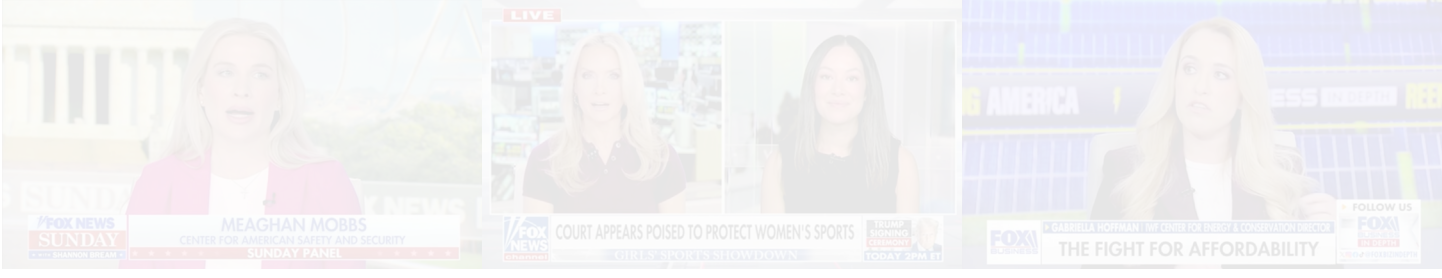

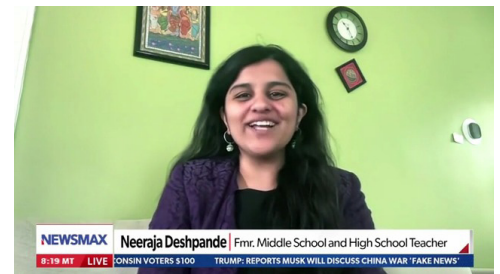

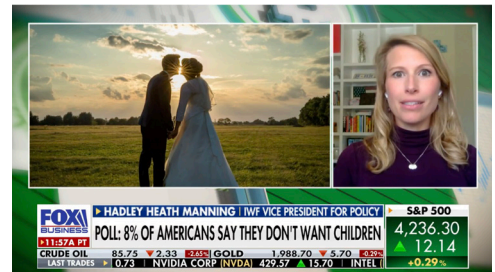

Dr. Ahmed is a physician, non-fiction author and broadcast media commentator. Her work has been published in The Guardian, The Wall Street Journal, The Spectator, Al Jazeera, The Independent, USA Today, The Daily Beast, the World Policy Journal, Fox News, CNN, and many others.

Dr. Ahmed is the first physician, and first Muslim woman, to be awarded the Templeton-Cambridge Fellowship in Journalism at the University of Cambridge, England.

A graduate of the University of Nottingham, Dr. Ahmed has practiced subspecialty medicine in the United Kingdom, the United States and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Currently, a triple board certified pulmonologist and sleep disorders specialist, Dr. Ahmed is appointed Associate Professor of Medicine at the State University of New York, an Honorary Professor at the School of Health and Life Sciences at Glasgow Caledonian University and an Honorary Fellow at the Technion-Israel Institute of Science and Technology. She is a Fellow of the American College of Chest Physicians, a Fellow of the American College of Physicians and a Fellow of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine.

In December 2015 Dr. Ahmed was naturalized as an American citizen. Today, she maintains dual British and U.S. citizenship and lives in New York where she continues to write and practice medicine.

Ellie Cohanim served as U.S. Deputy Special Envoy to Monitor and Combat Anti-Semitism at the U.S. Department of State during the Trump Administration. She was the State Department's first Iranian-born Jewish Envoy, and led diplomatic initiatives resulting in historic breakthroughs in the Muslim world including forging groundbreaking partnerships with the King Hamad Global Centre for Peaceful Co-Existence of Bahrain, and with Association Mimouna of Morocco, to combat anti-Semitism, anti-Zionism and Islamophobia; persuading the Global Imams Council (GIC) to adopt the IHRA working definition of anti-Semitism; and removal of anti-Semitic content from textbooks in the MENA region, all as part of the Abraham Accords efforts.

As Deputy Envoy, Ellie Cohanim was the lead official on creating and implementing policy on countering anti-Semitism in both the Middle East and North Africa (MENA), and Latin America regions.

Ellie Cohanim received her B.A. in Political Science, Cum Laude, from Barnard College, Columbia University; and conducted graduate study in International Relations at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. She is fluent in Hebrew and Farsi, familiar with German and Arabic.

The Honorable Nan Hayworth, M.D., is the first female physician elected to a full term as a Member of the House of Representatives, serving the 19th District of New York in the 112th Congress.

As a freshman in the House Majority, Nan was a member of the House Financial Services Committee and the Majority Whip Team; she was chosen by Speaker Boehner to serve on two House-Senate Conference Committees; and she worked with House Republican Conference Chair Jeb Hensarling on special communications initiatives with both fellow House members and Senators.

Nan makes regular appearances on television, streaming media, and radio, and in print, on behalf of the Independent Women, on whose board she serves.

A board-certified ophthalmologist, Nan had a private practice before becoming a vice president and medical director at Cline Davis & Mann from 2007 to 2009.

In addition to her work with Independent Women, Nan is chairman of the board of directors of ConservAmerica, a member of the boards of the Goodman Institute for Public Policy Research, Public Agenda, and United Way of Westchester and Putnam, and on the advisory board of the New Tolerance Campaign.

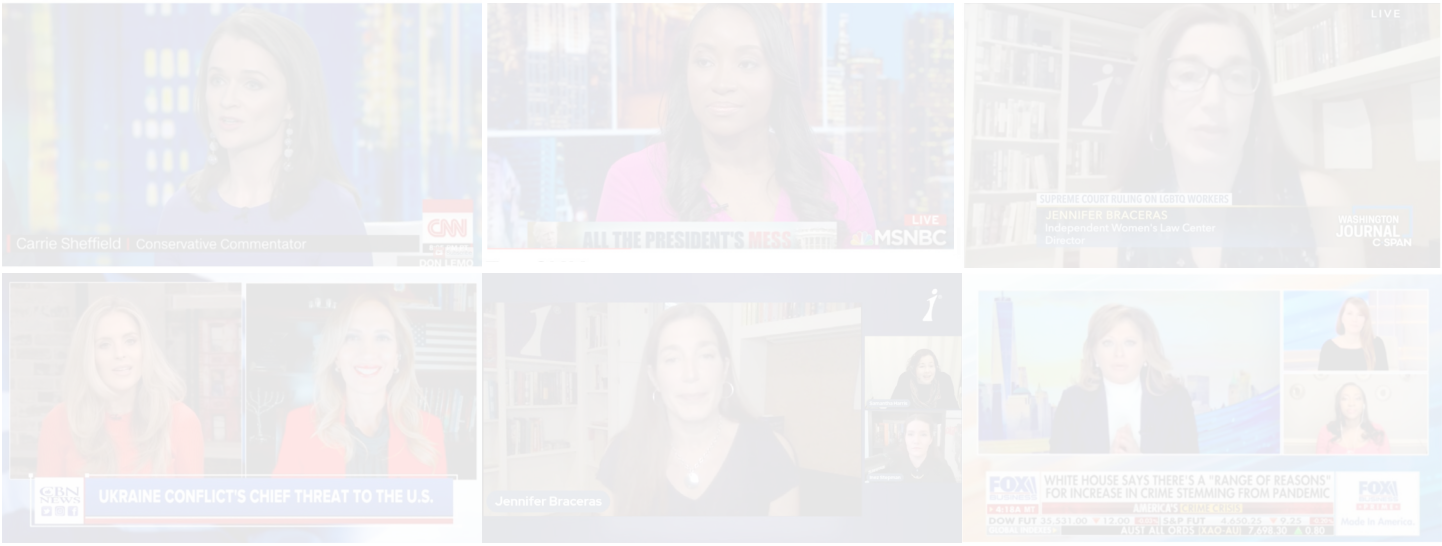
